The Hawaii State Art Museum (HiSAM) is the primary venue for the display and interpretation of the Art in Public Places (APP) Collection, a large collection of commissioned and relocatable artworks primarily by Hawaii artists.

The APP Program was created in 1967 with the Art-in-State-Buildings Law, a law that sets aside one percent of the construction cost of state buildings to commission and purchase works of visual art that beautify and humanize the environment.

The APP Program resides within the Hawaii State Foundation on Culture and the Arts, Hawaii's official arts agency.

The mission of the Hawaii State Foundation on Culture and the Arts is to promote, perpetuate, preserve, and encourage culture and the arts, history, and the humanities as central to the quality of life of the people of Hawaii.

Front Lawn

The Front Lawn is a fenced, landscaped area surrounded by monkeypod trees, coconut palms, and areca palms with entries at both Hotel and Richards Streets. The historic building is a stunning backdrop for any large event.

The elegant landscape is surrounded by the striking architecture of the State Capitol Building, 'Iolani Palace, and downtown Honolulu. The Front Lawn is suitable for events up to 1,500 people, such as non-profit fundraisers, corporate celebrations, or large receptions.

Includes: Front Lawn, 1st Fl. Kitchenette, Galleries

Capacity: 600 seated dinner
1,500 standing

Size: approx. 11,700 square feet

*Cost:** \$7,200 for five hour maximum

Events on the front lawn may not take place during State business hours. Setup and cleanup may take place during State business hours provided it does not interfere with the ability of the State to conduct business. Due to landscaping concerns, the front lawn is available for rental once every two weeks.

Second Floor Courtyard

The tranquil yet dramatic open-air Courtyard overlooks the historic YMCA swimming pool. In the evening, the Courtyard is lit by sconces and hanging fixtures. The Courtyard is suitable for meetings, wedding receptions, wine tastings, or intimate holiday parties.

Includes: Second Floor Courtyard, 2nd Floor Kitchenette, Galleries

Capacity: 150 seated dinner; 250 standing

Size: approx. 4,400 square feet

*Cost:** \$2,400 for five hour maximum

The Courtyard and/or Front Lawn is available Tuesday through Saturday after 4:00 pm (including setup).

OPTION III

Front Lawn & Second Floor Courtyard

Includes: Front Lawn, Second Fl. Courtyard, Galleries, 1st & 2nd Fl. Kitchenettes

Capacity: refer to options I & 2

Size: approx. 16,100 square feet

*Cost:** \$9,200 for five hour maximum

Museum Multipurpose Room

The quiet and comfortable Multipurpose Room is a private space with many seating possibilities. The Multipurpose Room is located on the first floor, Diamond Head side. A softly lit foyer serves as the entrance. The Multipurpose Room is suitable for groups of up to 70 people for events such as presentations, workshops, or meetings.

Capacity: 70 theater seating

Size: approx. 820 square feet

*Cost:** \$350

The Multipurpose Room is only available with the rental of another option package. The Multipurpose Room is not available for rental during regular museum hours.
