The Hawai'i State Art Museum (HiSAM) is seeking applicants for our 2015-2016 Docent Training Program. Participation in the program will prepare you to lead visitors on interactive and interpretive tours through HiSAM galleries. HiSAM exhibitions are curated from the **Art in Public Places Program Collection (APP)**, a program of the **Hawai'i State Foundation on Culture and the Arts (HSFCA)**.

The Docent Training Program at HiSAM provides multiple unique opportunities: you will become knowledgeable about the artists and artworks in the APP Collection; learn about Hawai'i's cultural and artistic heritage; meet and interact with artists and noted cultural leaders; receive training and gain experience in making public presentations, and help support the mission of the HSFCA:

The **Hawai'i State Foundation on Culture and the Arts** was established by the Hawai'i State Legislature in 1965, to promote, perpetuate, preserve and encourage culture and the arts, history and the humanities as central to the quality of life of the people of Hawai'i. HSFCA funding is provided by the State of Hawai'i and the National Endowment for the Arts.

Required: an interest in the visual arts, willingness and ability to commit to a 4-month training program, and upon graduation to lead gallery tours twice a month. Tours take place during museum hours, Tuesday – Saturday between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. and they will run approximately 1 hour each.

Please submit this form if you are interested in becoming a docent at HiSAM. We will begin our training program this upcoming **October 2015**. Meetings will be held on Thursdays from **1pm – 4pm**. Our Docent Training Program will run for 16 weeks, with breaks for the Holidays, and will end in February 2016. Public transportation encouraged, but parking provided if needed.
