

2019 Young Artists of Hawai'i Art Exhibition Official Guide



Young Artists of Hawai'i is an annual student art competition and exhibition that recognizes creative excellence among Hawaii's public and private school students in grades Kindergarten through sixth grade. This exhibit is presented by the Hawai'i State Foundation on Culture and the Arts and the Hawai'i Tourism Authority. The program provides opportunities for students to participate in a juried art competition. A panel of distinguished judges select 96 works for exhibition from school submissions.



The mission of the Hawai'i State Foundation on Culture and the Arts (SFCA) is to promote, perpetuate, preserve and encourage culture and the arts as central to the quality of life of the people of Hawai'i. SFCA funding is provided by the State of Hawai'i and the National Endowment for the Arts.

The 2019 Young Artists of Hawai'i Art Exhibition will be on display at the Hawai'i State Art Museum (HiSAM) from May 3, 2019 to June 28, 2019.



The Hawai'i Convention Center (HCC) showcases commissioned works by some of Hawaii's most distinguished artists. Along with this, a prominent courtyard area has been designed to exhibit student artwork from Hawaii's schools. Thousands of visitors who come to the HCC will be able to view our islands, people, and culture through the eyes of our students' artwork.

A replica of the 2019 Young Artists of Hawai'i Art Exhibition will be on display from April 2019 through March 2020 in the Pa Kamali'i Courtyard on the third floor of the HCC.

THEME

"My Culture, My Family, and Me"

Teachers may use the following questions to guide students in creating their artwork:

- What does your culture mean to you?
- What does your family mean to you?
- How does your culture influence you and your family?
- Why is your culture important to you and your family?
- What do you and your family do that represents your culture?

ELIGIBILITY

- Any student in kindergarten to sixth grade, enrolled in a public, charter, or private school in Hawaii.
- Art schools are not eligible.
- One entry per student. Work created by two or more students will not be accepted.
- Only current work for the year will be accepted. Please do not submit work that was entered in a previous year.

FORMAT

- 18" x 24" size white or colored paper.
- No frames. Students should work to the edge of the paper.
- Artwork must have a HORIZONTAL orientation.
- Do not mat or frame the artwork.
- Artwork may be signed by the student on the back lower-right-hand corner in small letters, under two inches in height. No other letters or words should be on the artwork.
- Accepted mediums are watercolor or acrylic paints, oil pastels, colored inks, or colored chalk with a fixative agent. Paper collages and mixed media are accepted as long as it is two-dimensional and will lay flat.

ENTRY FORM

- Submit with two copies of the entry form. Adhere one entry form to the back left corner of the artwork; tape the second on top of the first entry form.
- Type in entry form, if possible. Entry form must be legible and complete. No nicknames.

INVENTORY FORM

- Please complete the attached inventory form and turn in with the artwork.
- Keep a duplicate of the inventory form for your own file.
- Type entry form, if possible.
