Description: Educators will learn to guide students in creating oil pastels about nature based on observations of Hawai'i landscapes, incorporating art concepts such as perspective.

The course will begin with a focus on 'reading' works of art. When students observe and describe artworks, they learn how to interpret the images and make personal connections to the world presented in the art. As they build observation, critical- and creative-thinking skills, students are well-prepared to create richer, more expressive artworks of their own.

The course will include **in-person sessions**, asynchronous work plus visits to each educator's classroom to actively demonstrate techniques with students and to observe activities facilitated by each course participant.
