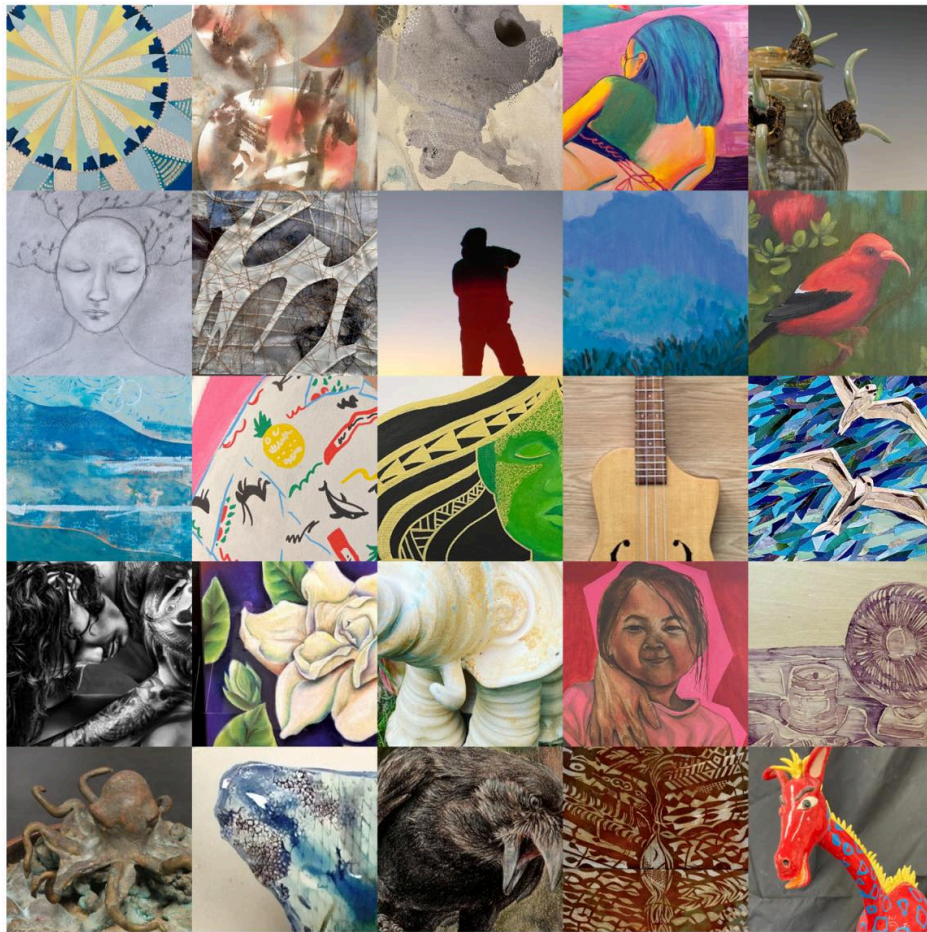

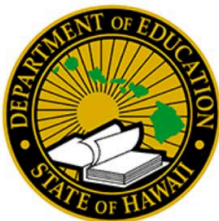
Visual Arts teachers design and implement Art lessons and activities that meet the goals of the Hawai'i State Department of Education (HIDOE), and the needs and interests of their students. The primary goal of Visual Arts education is to develop visually literate and aesthetically sensitive students who function in society as creators, appreciators and consumers of Art.

The Arts assist us to make sense of the world and develop creative skills. Being able to train your mind to think creatively helps you invent, problem-solve, create and communicate in fresh, new ways. Creative thinkers are in high demand in the job market and creative thinking is one of the key skills needed in future jobs.

Nā Hopena A'o (HĀ) consists of outcomes to be strengthened in every student and demonstrated by teachers and staff of the HIDOE. The outcomes include a sense of Belonging, Responsibility, Excellence, Aloha, Total Wellbeing and Hawai'i. When taken together, these outcomes become the core BREATH that can be drawn on for strength and stability throughout school and beyond.
